Carrots can be farmed and harvested on farmland.Planted carrots take 8 stages to grow, and go through 4 visually distinct stages. Mature carrot crops drop 1 to 5 carrots (about 3 per crop harvested on average). Bone meal can be used on carrots. Using a tool enchanted with fortune increases the maximum number of carrots dropped by 1 per level.

Just as close proximity to other carrots can cause twisting and branching, weeds have underground roots that can get in the way of growth as well, and they will also compete for nutrients. Make sure to keep your beds weeded throughout the growing season, so that weeds don't interfere with your root crop.

You just need to make sure that your pot is deep enough to hold the carrots and allow the roots to expand. 2. Either spread the seeds at random or plant in rows. If planting in rows, space the seeds about 1-2 inches (2.5-5.1 cm) apart in a shallow trench, no more than 1/2 inch (1.3 cm) deep.

Deformed carrots can be caused by a variety of problems and may be forked, bumpy, or otherwise misshapen. These carrots are usually edible, although the core may become woody and slightly bitter. In fact, many of the baby carrots you purchase as snacks are just whittled down deformed carrots.

Carrot Problems - What Causes Deformities In Carrots

If your soil feels heavy and as though it would be hard for the carrots to develop in it then be sure to add a good amount of compost. Carrots need sandy, loose soil, with a pH between 6.0 to 6.8. It should also be well-draining. Go over the soil with a rakeand make sure there are no lumps or rocks in it.
