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Developing A Scheme Of Work

Create a scheme of work from scratch. Use a Word document (and make a table on it) or create an Excel spreadsheet to write your schedule of work. Start by adding the basic information and add to the document as you wish (e.g. adding a column called "Initials" or "Signature" at the end of the chart to sign and show that a learning goal was completed on schedule .

A scheme of work, in short, is an overview or a long-term plan for what you aim to teach in a particular subject across a term or an academic year. It's a road map for where you want to go and the steps you will need to take in order to get there. Typically, a schoolteacher will need to put in place a scheme of work for each subject they will be teaching.

Lesson planning and ideas: Creating a scheme of work

A scheme of work defines the structure and content of an academic course. It splits an often-multi-year curriculum into deliverable units of work, each of a far shorter weeks' duration (e.g. two or three weeks). Each unit of work is then analysed out into teachable individual topics of even shorter duration (e.g. two hours or less).
