Adhesive dentistry can save a patient's teeth. One way to successfully place an adhesive includes first etching the tooth. Etching in adhesive dentistry is the process of using a chemical such as phosphoric acid to remove debris including plaque from the surface of the tooth to which a dental professional seeks to attach new material.

Put the denture into your mouth and firmly close the mouth for a couple of seconds. If the adhesive cream overflows you have used too much. Remove any spare adhesive, don't swallow it. Don't eat or drink anything for 5 minutes. Before you sleep, take your denture out. Clean the denture and the inside of your mouth thoroughly to remove any adhesive.
