Fold a piece of paper in half. For a standard snowflake, normal printer paper (8.5 x 11) is just fine. To get fancy, decorate your paper beforehand in colored pencil, crayon, or marker. Or use colored paper!

(TO MAKE A SQUARE: You can make a square from a rectangular piece of paper simply by folding one corner down to form an isosceles triangle and trimming off the excess paper. See second picture.) I usually make two snowflakes for every 8.5"x11" piece of paper, so I first cut the paper in half, and then make a square from each half.

Cut-outs are pre-printed and pre-cut images that can be quickly assembled on a scrapbook page or card to give it incredible sharpness and style. These are also called die cuts or die cuts shapes. The laser cutting technique used on these paper cutouts is so incredibly precise, it results in beautiful and accurate paper embellishments.

Start with a square piece of paper. (Tip: To cut a perfect square from a standard 8-by-11-inch sheet of paper, fold paper into a right-angled triangle; trim off excess.) Fold paper in half diagonally to make a triangle. Fold paper triangle in half so that the pointed corners meet.

Cut your strips to size (we used a miter saw), sand and paint red. Gather your paper and lay flat. Flip your wood cutout upside down and place it on the backside of the paper. Trace around it with a pencil.

We used a regular print paper, but we do recommend using the lightest paper you got, to make the cutting easier. Use your scissors to cut out the square. First, we need to fold the square in half to get a triangle. Fold this triangle in half, as shown in the picture below.

Flatten out on your workspace and smooth it out a bit. Using oil pastels or crayon rub a little color onto the paper. It works best if you take the wrapper off and then use the side. Fold the paper in half with the color to the inside.
