Prescription drugs: The most common types of prescription drugs abused in 2017 were pain relievers, tranquilizers, stimulants, and sedatives. 7 In 2017, about 1.7 million people age 12 and older had a pain reliever use disorder, or about 0.6% of this population. 1 Women may more rapidly develop a prescription painkiller dependence than men.
