When teaching the alphabet, it's important to work on both letter recognition and phonics. Kids need to differentiate between each letter, using the different shapes to make this distinction. They also need to match uppercase and lowercase letters together.

How to Teach the Alphabet

The Pre-reading level goes through the alphabet three times, first capital letters, then lower case, then learning letter sounds. This incremental approach is very helpful for many children. However, some children do fine with learning capital, lower case, and sound of a letter together, say a letter a week.
